## Proposed Amendments to Troop Guidelines:

Two amendments to the Troop Guidelines have been proposed and will be voted on at the September Committee meeting.

The first amendment will allow the troop Committee selectively to allow adult Scouters under 21 to drive Scouts to and from outings. Previously adults under 21 were not allowed to drive youth. Scouts riding with an adult under 21 will need to have written parental permission.

The second amendment will require all registered adults to participate in at least three activities per year. This is intended to encourage more adult involvement that is necessary for a successful troop.

Please consider whether you support either of these amendments and tell your decision to a Committee member. Also, please come to the Committee meeting on Sep. 10 to help decide the matter.

#### September and October Activities:

The Centennial District Camporee will be Sep. 13–15. Jim George will offer the National Heritage Award at the troop meeting on Sep. 23. This award is available to youth and adults. Centennial District will offer New Leader Essentials and Youth Protection training on Sep. 27, and Leader-Specific and Troop Committee training on Sep. 29.
